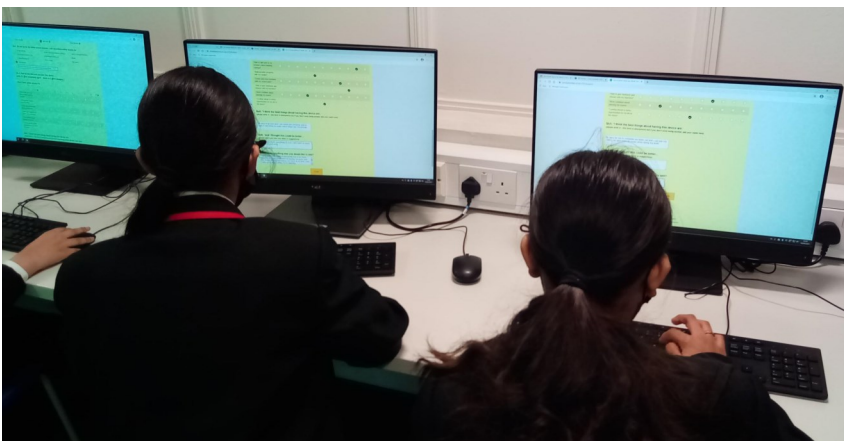
**The digital divide intensified during Covid19 but remains a challenging gulf, losing education and life opportunities for many disadvantaged pupils, with its ensuing impact on society.**
