## **PRIVATE TOUR & LUNCH FOR 2 AT THE PALACE OF WESTMINSTER**

A special Private Tour of the Palace of Westminster for 2 people accompanied by The Master, Jennifer Bryant-Pearson, which will commence at 11am.

The Palace of Westminster serves as the meeting place for both the House of Commons and the House of Lords. It was built in 1016, demolished in 1843 and rebuilt between 1840 and 1876. The Palace of Westminster has been a Grade 1 listed building since 1970 and is part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1987. The Palace is owned by the Her Majesty, The Queen, in right of the Crown.

Highlights of the Tour include Westminster Hall, the oldest building on the parliamentary estate, built in 1097 under William 11 and the Commons Crypt, the Chapel of St Mary Undercroft, which is one of the few structures in the Palace to survive the Great Fire as well as the two debating chambers.

Lunch afterwards will be served in the House of Commons, hosted by the Master, Jennifer Bryant-Pearson and her chosen MP.
