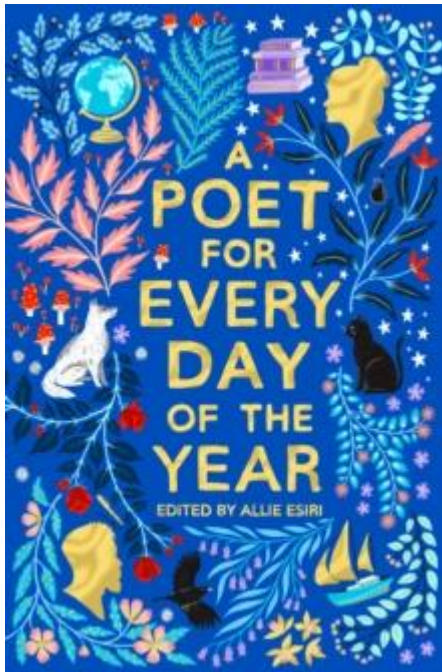
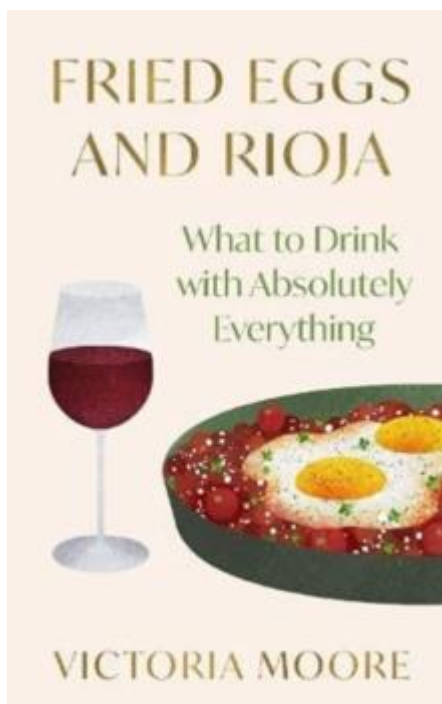

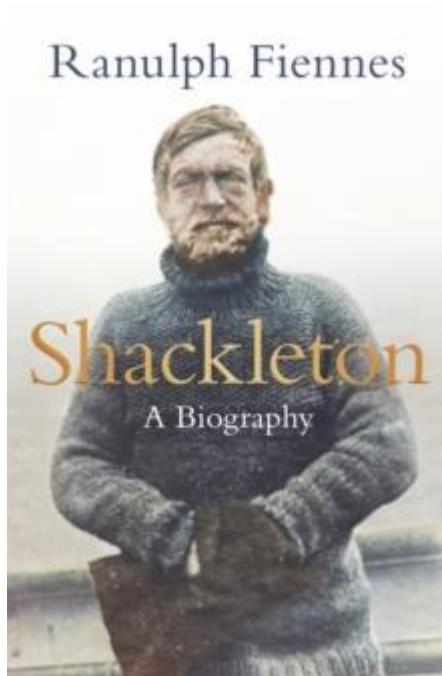
A Poet for Every Day of The Year edited by Allie Esiri, hardback, £20.00

The perfect present for so many. Which wine goes with which food? This brilliant book works for budding chefs and wine lovers alike and offers not only great pairings but some great recipes too.



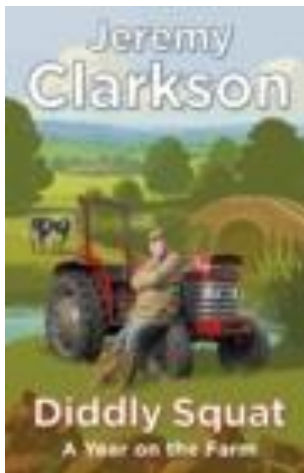
Shackleton: A Biography by Ranulph Fiennes, hardback, £20.00

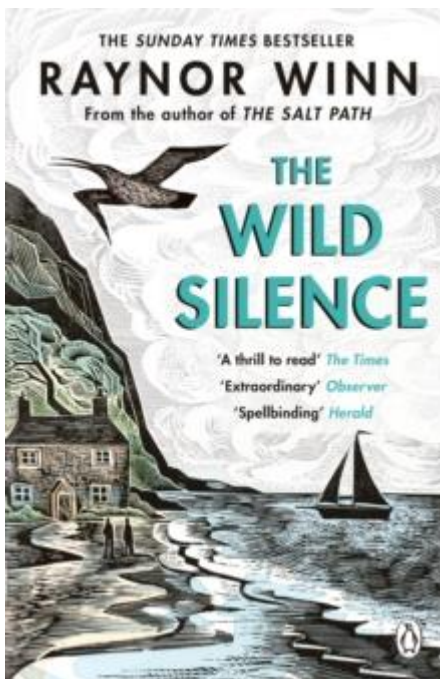
Ottolenghi Test Kitchen: Shelf Love, flexiback, £25.00

The best guide of all this Christmas on how to raid your kitchen and whip up something wonderful to feed the family.



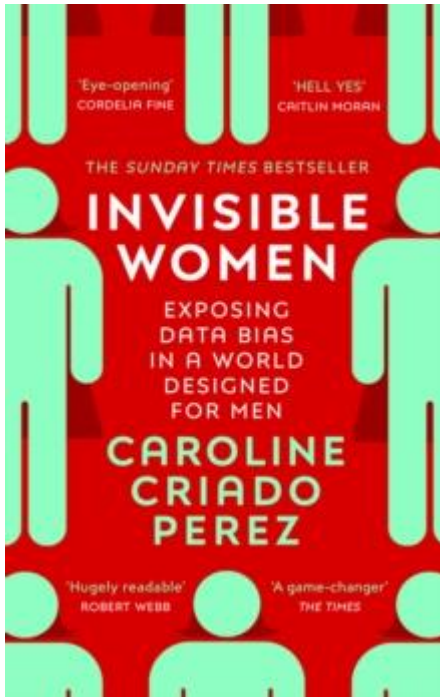
Diddly Squat: A Year on the Farm by Jeremy Clarkson, hardback, £16.99
