The Brigantes Golf Day returns to Ganton Golf Club near Scarborough, a top Championship course, having staged the Ryder Cup, Walker Cup and Curtis Cup, and noted for its immaculate greens and spectacular views.

Since 2021, when we were last at Ganton, the Club has hosted the English Open Amateur Championship, the British Seniors Amateur Championship – and this summer welcomed 288 players from 26 countries for the British Boys and British Girls Championships.
